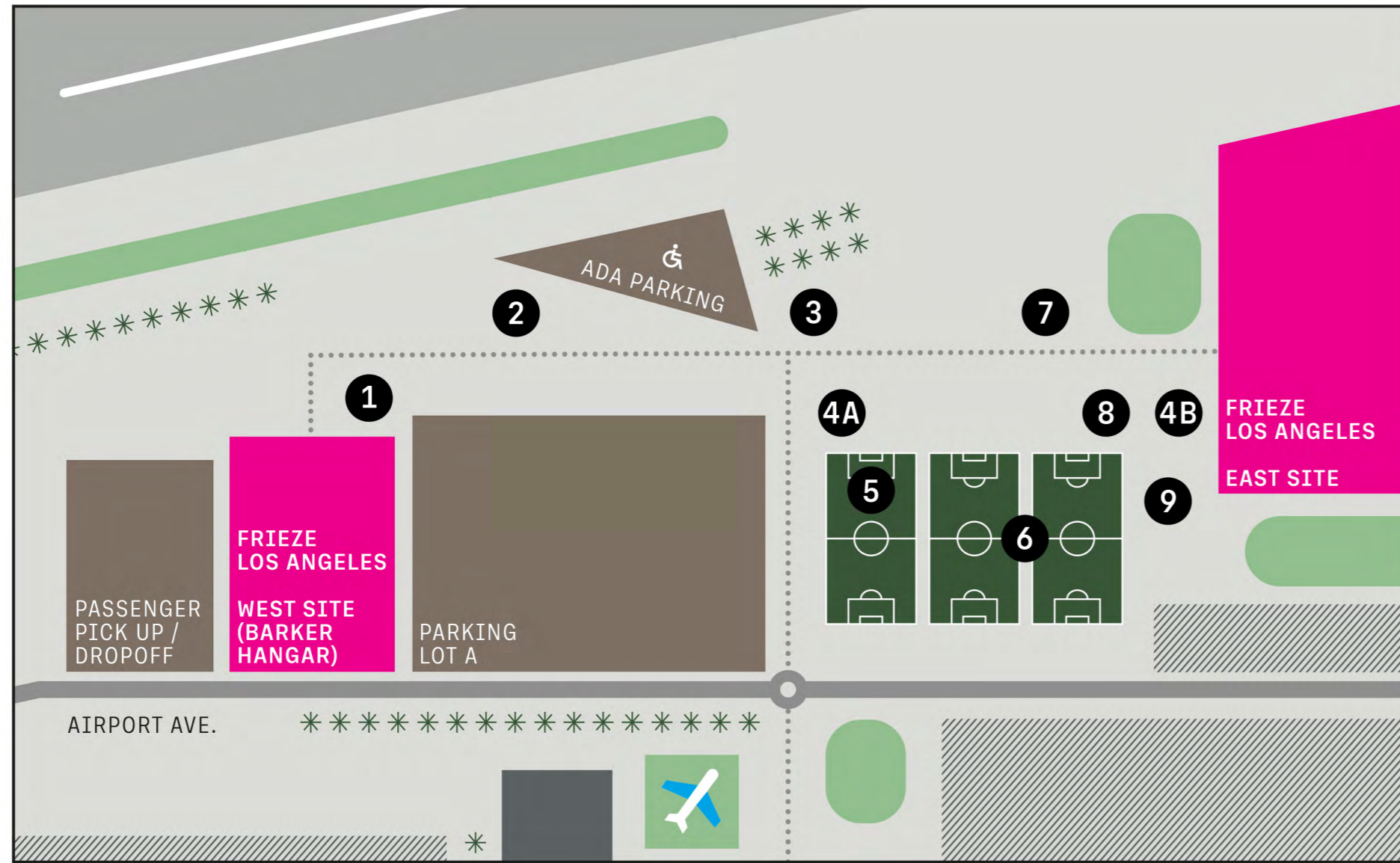


FRIEZE PROJECTS: NOW PLAYING

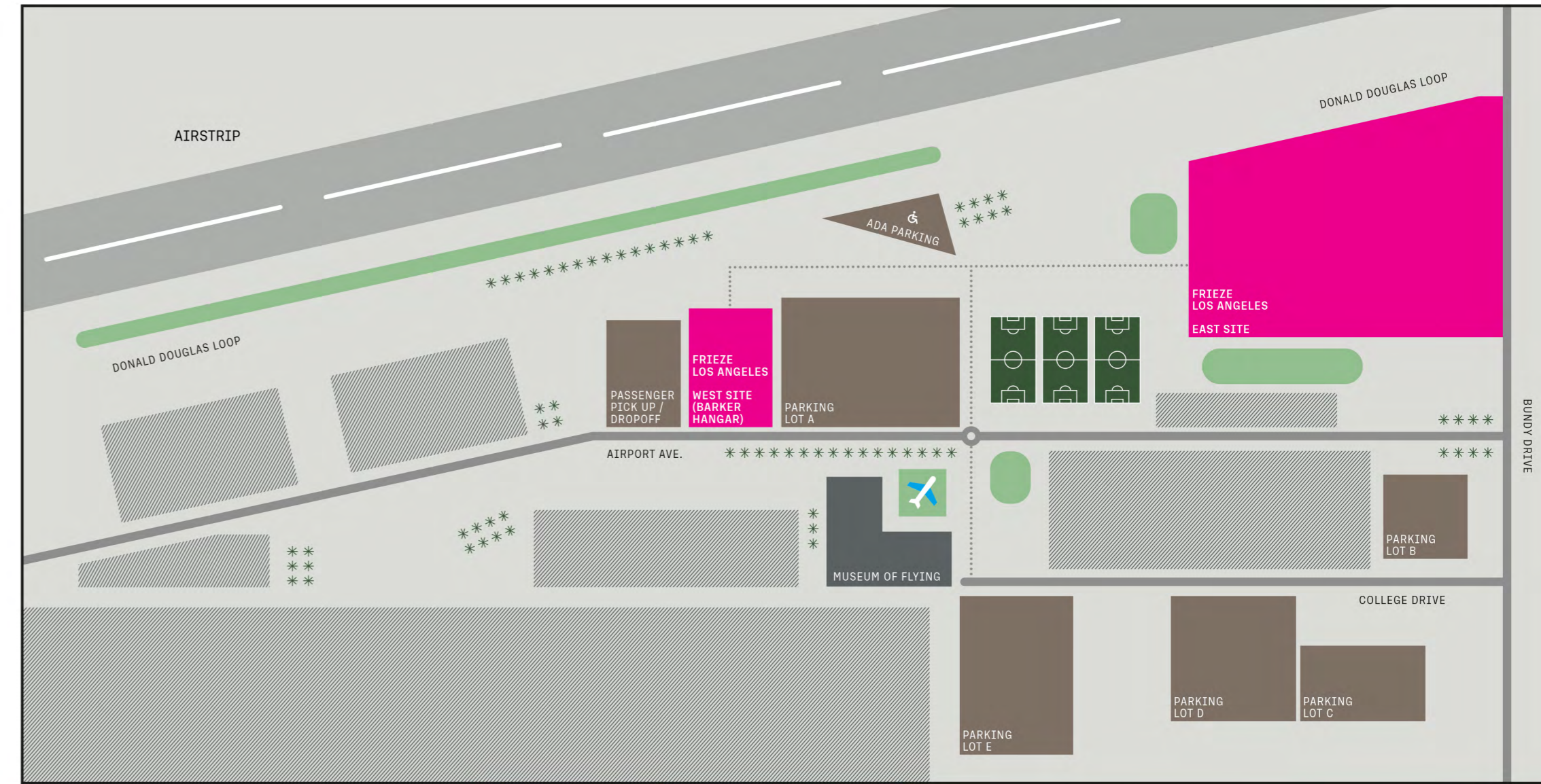

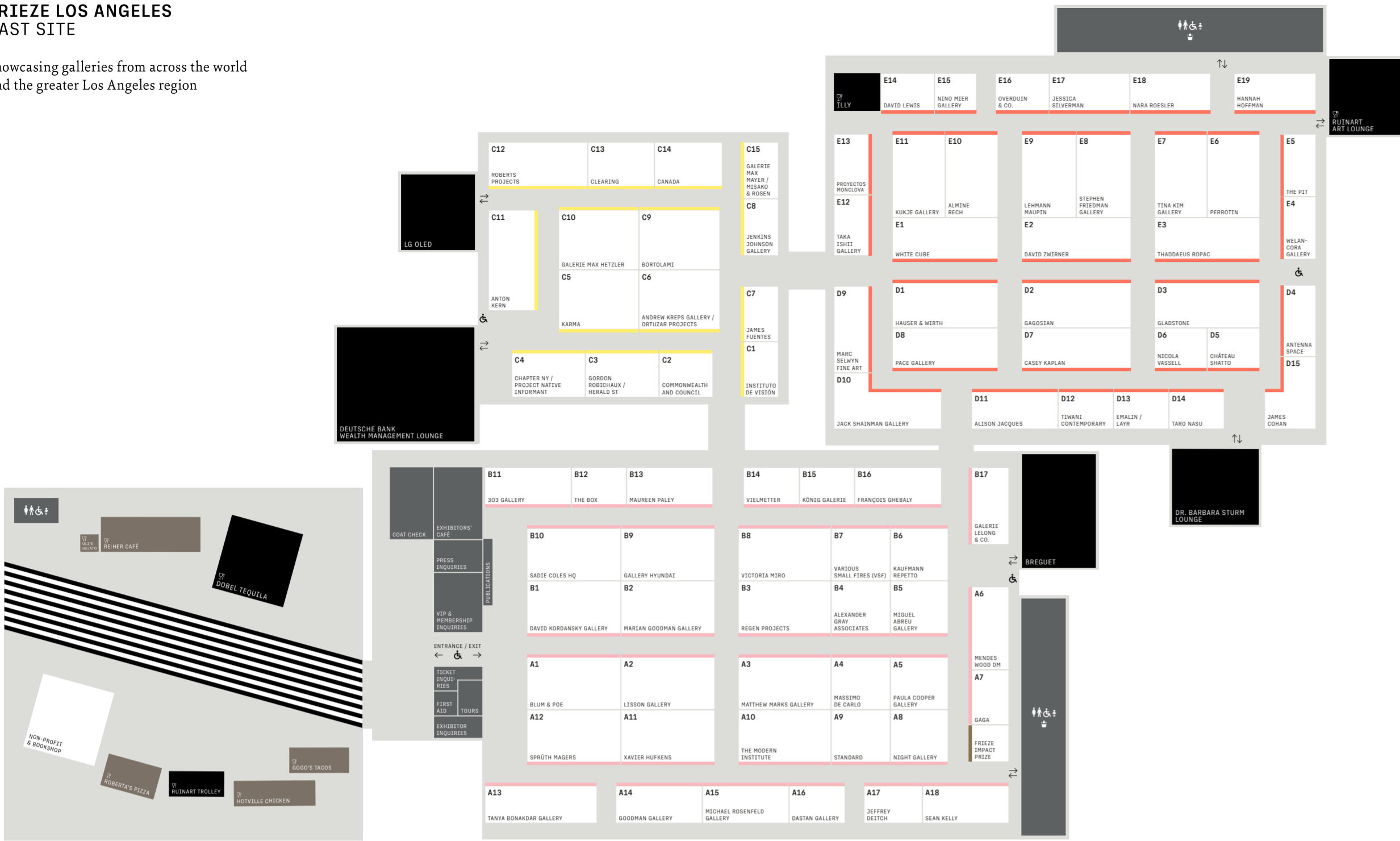

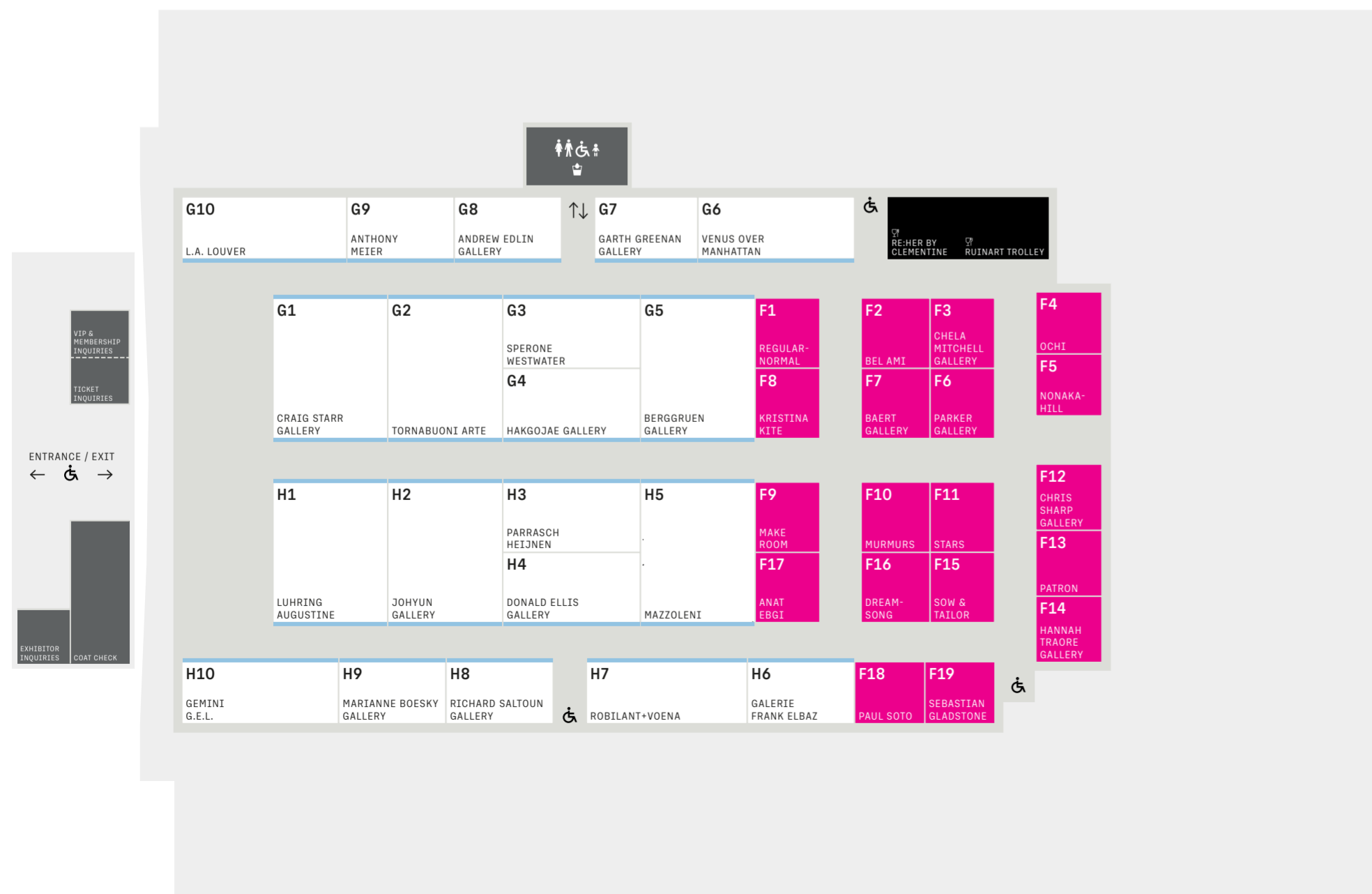
